GOALS

SCHOOL YEAR 2015-2016

1. Increase the percentage of students scoring proficient or advance by five percent (5%) each year on all state assessments with a goal of meeting the state average by 2017.
2. Increase the graduation rate by ten percent (10%) each year with a goal of eighty percent (80%) by 2017.
3. Increase the District's average daily attendance (ADA) to a consistent range of ninety six percent (96%) to ninety eight percent (98%).
4. Increase teacher retention to ninety percent (90%) and maintain it at ninety percent (90%) and strive to attract highly qualified staff.
5. Increase parental/stakeholder involvement through communication and relevant contact to promote life-long learning.
6. Clearly outline teacher accountability and provide staff support through professional development and positive reinforcement.
7. Increase the district ACT score by five percent (5%) each year with a goal of meeting the state average by 2017.
8. Enhance the use of technology to increase student engagement and create learning environments that develop students that are college and career ready.
